Passing out of forty four (44) SPLA Medical Officers

The Sudan People's Liberation Army (SPLA) General Headquarters is celebrating today the 14th April 2007, the passing out or graduation of four (44) Medical Officers who were recruited in December 2006 and completed their basic military training for a period of six (6) weeks in Pariak SPLA Training Centre. The following is categories of the graduates:

1. Twenty four (24) Medical Doctors;
2. Five (5) Public Health Officers and Managers;
3. Four (4) Laboratory Technologists and Technicians;
4. Six (6) Clinical Officers; and
5. Five (5) Nurses.

It is worth noting that the number of the medical doctors in the SPLA during last twenty four (24) year was less than 10 doctors. Therefore, the pass out of forty four (44) Medical Officers and their subsequent deployment to the SPLA Units will improve the medical services in the SPLA.

The SPLA will continue to recruit more Medical Officers and a new advertisement to that effect will be released to the media within coming few days.

The SPLA GHQs is also celebrating in this occasion the passing out of eleven (11) SPLA Military Instructors who have successfully completed a course on Curriculum Development and Management of Military and Academic Institutions for a period of four (4) weeks in one of the Military Institutions in the Region.
